### Regional Alliance IRELAND – Training Delivered at Ignite Creative Pod

The CCIC Alliance in Ireland is led by Roscommon Leader Partnership with support from Momentum Marketing Services. Stakeholders in the Alliance include local authorities, local training organisations and enterprise agencies and specifically those in these organisations who involved in supporting the creative sector. One of the key actions this Alliance has achieved is the establishment of a Creative Hub in Ballaghaderreen called the Ignite Creative Pod.

In January 2017, Momentum delivered the classroom format <u>CCIC Course</u> was delivered as a pilot test with 13 budding creative Irish entrepreneurs with a view to helping them to set up a creative business. Ignite combined expert led workshops, mentoring (from the <u>Local Enterprise Office Roscommon</u>) and use of a collaborative working space for 6 months in Ballaghaderreen.
